HOW TO HELP YOUR CHILD

- Read with your child at home. If possible, please read a story to your child every day.
- Talk with your child at every opportunity. This will help to develop listening, speaking and understanding skills.
- ➤ Encourage your child to develop their independence, encouraging them to use the toilet independently, walk into nursery independently and put on their own coat.
- Collect items to show, related to topics being taught in class.
- We have been learning about rhyming words. Singing nursery rhymes and reading rhyming stories together will help your child to develop this skill.

THINGS TO REMEMBER

FRIDAY – We will have our 'Forest School' sessions on Friday morning. Please send your child into school wearing clothing suitable for the weather (wellies and waterproofs, or sun hat and sun cream). Also please send a bag of spare clothes.

UNIFORM: Please make sure that your child's uniform is **clearly labelled**; we have so many children that items of uniform are easily lost. Children with long hair must have it tied back in a hair bobble.

WATER BOTTLES: The children in nursery are welcome to bring a water bottle. Please ensure your child's water bottle is named a refilled every day.

HOMEWORK: Children in nursery will not receive weekly homework. However, we encourage parents to share children's home experiences with us which we can use towards evidence of their learning. Please upload home learning onto Class Dojo.

LIBRARY BOOKS

Your child will bring home a library book every Wednesday. Please read to your child every day. Library books will bechanged once a week (Wednesday) and a new book will be allocated.

SNACK: All children in EYFS are offered fruit each day, these vary from raisins, pears, apples etc. In addition to this, we also provide a healthy snack such as toast, yogurt or cheese to encourage children to try different foods. The cost for snack is £1 a week and can be paid at the school office.
