- Check your child's reading packet each day.
- Check Class Dojo for any messages and updates of learning.

#### THINGS TO REMEMBER

<u>TUESDAY</u> is our P.E. day. Please come to school dressed in your PE kit. Earrings must be taken out at home, please. Also, please can children bring in either pumps or trampolining socks, to leave in school. We will use these when we are in the hall for PE. Some weeks we will have an additional PE lesson on a **Thursday**, I will let you know when this is via Class Dojo. Children should wear the school P.E kit (navy shorts and red t-shirt).

**<u>UNIFORM:</u>** Please make sure that your child's uniform is clearly labelled; we have so many children that items of uniform and P.E. kit are easily lost. Children with long hair must have it tied back in a hair bobble.

**WATER BOTTLES:** Please make sure that children bring a clearly labelled water bottle into school each day.

**HOMEWORK**: Will be sent home each Friday and is due back each Wednesday.

**SNACK:** All children in KS1 are offered healthy fruit each day, these vary from raisins, pears, apples etc. You can also send your child to school with a healthy snack in addition to this. No nuts please.

**READING BOOKS:** Reading books will be changed every **MONDAY.** Please bring your child's reading book into school every day.

**SPELLINGS:** All children will receive spellings on a **MONDAY**. They will be tested on these spellings at the end of the week, on **FRIDAY**. The spellings will be related to the book they are reading that week. Please practice writing them

#### **READING BOOKS**

Your child will bring home a Read, Write, Inc. book bag book which is linked to the level they are working at. The books are closely linked with the book read in school and offer additional practise reading the graphemes taught that week. Please read with your child every day and sign their diary. Reading books will be changed at least once a week and a new book will be allocated. Children will read at different times during the week. Please ensure your child brings their reading book and diary to school every day. Your child will also bring home a book from the 100 books challenge to enjoy together.
